## The European house is much better than its reputation

Currently it is quite chic to do some EU-bashing and to hold sepultural speeches on the European Union. And whoever likes to bait on the EU, easily finds enough occasions to do so: ongoing attempts to solve the economic problems in Greece, the inability to find a common asylum and refugee policy, the helplessness against the Russian aggression in Ukraine and the unwillingness to defend its own principles courageously against the pretentiousness of neo-autocrats. Having all this in mind many wellmeaning young people angrily ask

themselves what the use is of this powerful entity and for what do we need it really for. All kinds of allegations are made and the EU is blamed for its mismanagement, loss of sense of reality, self-blockade and growing alienation of its apparatus from the citizens. On the other hand we all should not be surprised that the path towards a European unification will not be an easy stroll through a rose garden, rather it always was a walk through stony terrain.

In fairness one has to assert that European politics in general is not worse or less efficient than politics in the national states of Europe. In many countries people are yearning for the democratic standards and efficiency of the European institutions, because at home they suffer much more of corruption, missing transparency and horrible red tape.

Despite all justified and nonjustified criticism of the EU, I would like to defend the basic idea against the rampant skepticism of EU politics and institutions.

For about 15 years I accompanied Kolping youngsters to Strasbourg, where Anton Salesny organized the

annual international seminars at the Council of Europe and European Parliament. I could witness how this event changed the mindset of many youngsters within a week. On-site they could experience first-hand how seriously and committed the politicians and the staff in the EU administration are debating and working for the benefit of the people. Almost all of them significantly changed their minds and dropped their prejudices. Participants who had been diehard sceptics in the beginning, turned to emphatic backers of the European Union at the end of this event. The young Kolping members got access to many institutions and had the opportunity to get insight into the difficult task of finding common solutions and reasonable compromises between the member states.

How frustrating it must be for most of the participants of these Kolping seminars in Strasbourg to observe that many national parliaments are increasingly dominated by populists of the extreme right or left, between whom it is ever more difficult to find any differences. In a self-destructive manner they are uttering their resentments towards Europe and the EU, and are willing to relinquish the best and most precious thing that Europeans ever founded, just out of spoiled laziness to think and trendy hubris.

I am positive that the Brexit and the current erratic president of the US will contribute to a stronger unification of Europe and that the EU will come out invigorated of this crisis. We can learn this as well from the Chinese sages: in Chinese language the term crisis (危機) consists of a character which is built from the two terms of danger (危險) and opportunity (機會) (crisis = danger + opportunity). So we may always have the hope that in every danger there will be an element of change to the better. Let's not frivolously abandon the European institutions but rather try to strengthen all efforts to make them more accountable and democratic.

The second transnational meeting of the "Smart communication – smart youth participation" project took place in Braşov, from the 9th till the 12th of March 2017. The topic of the seminar funded by the Erasmus+ programme was "National communication and promotion tools to enhance empowerment, bottom-up youth initiatives".

### **Project — Model of Youth Development for Employment**




