

#### **CROATIA - EDUCATIONAL SUPPORT FOR CHILDREN**



Years 2018/2019 in one Croatian village and parish called Kneginec (near Varaždin, northern part of Croatia) was bit inovative Kolping in Youth Few activities. volunteers, with vocations different talents, and gathered in order to offer free educational support for elementary school children from the parish area.



the idea Although of free educational helping is not new and it is fortunately present all over the Croatia and world also, it was something new for this parish. Trying to see the needs in their surroundings, five volunteers (three Kolping members and two symphatizers) thought that offering the free educational support could be good option for all parents and children who are paying during the school year for additional educational support. So, those five volunteers offered their free time and knownledge in different materia in order to share it with other children. Few parents recognized this opportunity and they have included their children into this activity. Volunteers spread their free time and they were exchanging themsleves in materia and also in weeks so that children were covered with help every week during the school year (except during the school vacation Parson of the parish Kneginec offered the parish places for conductioning of this activity and it was great cooperation that will continue.

#### INTERCONTINENTAL COOPERATION



Since 1 November 2018 the Kolping Foundation in Poland is coordinating an intercontinental youth capacity building project. This is the first time, as we get the support from the European Commission for the activities with non-european countries as Honduras and Mexico!

Few of the high-lights of the project are the international youth exchange in Mexico in August 2019 for 20 active youth from Romania, Poland, Honduras and Germany (diocese Paderborn), mobilities for youth workers in all partner countries and the final event in Poland – Fair Trade Week in Mai 2020.

The main assumptions of the project are to **educate youth workers** from involved partner organizations about different ways of rising youth employment using different available resources, tools and mechanisms and to equip youth with key competences needed for labour market by increasing European and Partners country cooperation.





#### Project "COFFEE - cooperation for fair economy and education" aims to:

- foster cooperation and exchanges in the field of youth work with emphasis on increasing youth employment Countries between Programme (Poland, Germany, Romania) and Partner Countries (Honduras, Mexico) thanks to creation and improvement partnership organizations active in youth work to empower young people on labour market, especially to assist youth in an integrated way
- improve the quality of youth work and non-formal learning in all countries taking part in the project, especially due to education of youth workers
- Programme and Partner Countries, especially targeting young people with fewer opportunities, with a view to improving participants' level of key competences and fostering their active participation in society due to creation of cooperation between youth organizations based on mobility activities

• empower youth organisations to rise youth employment thanks to realization of capacity building project and to cooperation, networking and peer-learning activities fostering efficient management and gaining new ideas, methods and tools

One of the aims of the project is to create, on the basis of national experience, the best practice toolkit "Model of youth leaders development for fair economy and education".

These materials will represent a synthesis of various national experiences and a tool for reflection on methods which youth organizations will be able to use throughout Europe and Partner countries.

# Project "Model of youth development for employment" is successfully finished!

Foster cooperation and exchanges in the field of youth work with an emphasis on increasing the youth employment between Poland, Romania and Serbia – these were the main goals of the successfully finished international youth project.

All together 21 youth workers met 3 times during the project implementation and developed the following topics:

- Entrepreneurial thinking in Serbia, Novi Sad: 26-30.
   June 2017 (21 participants, 7 per country)
- Social Entrepreneurship in Romania, Timisoara: 25-29 October 2017 (21 participants, 7 per country)
- Managerial and Leadership skills in Poland,
   Krakow: 16-20 May 2018 (21 participants, 7 per country)
- As a final part of the project the coordinator Kolping Society in Serbia - organized the *youth exchange* for 27 youngsters from Poland, Romania and Serbia.

#### **ENTREPRENEURSHIP EDUCATION**

The Serbian youth workers, trained during the previous project activities, were leading one week workshops for young people, who wanted to foster their situation on the labour market. (Youth exchange action "*Me on the labour market*" – in Serbia, Sremski Karlovci: 13-18 August 2018).

#### **EDUCATION TROUGH ART AND CULTURE**

"Art & Heart – Tools to connect people and change the world" – was the topic of the international youth project coordinated by Obra Kolping Portugal in cooperation with Kolping societies from Poland, Lithuania, Slovenia and Germany (Kolpingakademie Ingolstadt).

The goal of the project was to bring together young people between ages of 18 to 25 through various activities related to culture and art. The youngsters participated in 3 international exchanges, prepared by Portugal, German and Polish partners.



## 28.08-03.09.2018, LAMEGO, PORTUGAL

First exchange took place in beautiful city Lamego headquarter of Portugal Kolping Society in the northern part of the country. On the arrival day the music band "897 Songs do Douro" welcomed the participants. Next day was dedicated to dance – with the trainer Roberto Sabenci from the ArtDance School young people tried the modern dance. In the afternoon group had a meeting with João Pedro Fonseci photographer and artist.

During the meeting was also an opportunity to enjoy the traditional dance and music with the group "Rancho regional de Fafel". Participants visited several museums and everyone could prepare their own traditional facial mask. On the farewell day group participated in the ship cruise on the Douro river.

## 15-21.12.2018, INGOLSTADT, GERMANY

The next youth exchange in the framework of this project was held in Ingolstadt in Germany few days before Christmas time. All together 19 youngsters with 5 leaders discussed about stereotypes and prepared the

This time participants could try to dance break dance and meditate, and one day of the meeting was dedicated to the painting.

Into the programme was included also a visit to the Audi museum – one of the most famous places in the city and the visit to the Christmas market with the traditional Bayarian food.

#### 11-17.04.2019, KRAKÓW, POLAND

Third meeting with 26 people was held in Luborzyca near Krakow, where is situated the Meeting Centre of polish Kolping Society.

During a one week participants visited several Polish museums with works of the most famous Polish artists from XIX and XX century and orthodox paints (Museum of Erazm Ciołek). Time of the meeting falled to the Palm Sunday period and the group used the opportunity to prepare the traditional Polish Sunday palms and present them on the Holy Mass in Wawel Castle.

One day was dedicated to wooden art – everyone could prepare their own sculpture and try to work as an real sculptor. The additional attraction was the pizza workshop in scouts house, where everyone could prepare his/her favorite Pizza.



The young people established new contacts and international partnerships, improved their English knowledge and communication skills. Many of them are planning next international trips and projects with their new friends.
